TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR DISPOSAL OF OLD CONDEMNED UNSERVICEABLE ITEMS

1. Interested Parties may submit their highest prices for the purchase of obsolete and unserviceable computers, printers and UPS with batteries and copier machine by 5:00 PM on or before 11th June 2018 along with Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 5,000/- by **Demand Draft drawn in favour of the Director, NCDIR, Bengaluru, superscribed as “TENDER FOR DISPOSAL OF CONDEMNED UNSERVICEABLE ITEMS”**. The tender form fee and EMD amount is payable by means of Demand Draft in favour of Director, NCDIR, Bengaluru. **(Payment by Cheque/Cash shall not be accepted)**.
2. NCDIR, Bengaluru will not be responsible for delayed / late tenders submitted / sent by post / Courier etc.
3. Tender's received after stipulated date/ time / late/ incomplete/ delayed and also without tender form fee and EMD amount will not be considered at all by this office.
4. Submission of tender: Only physical bids received by NCDIR, Bengaluru office will be considered for opening. Bids sent through fax or email will not be considered.
5. The disposal of condemned unserviceable items shall be strictly on “AS IS WHERE IS BASIS”. The condemned unserviceable item can be inspected physically between 10:00 AM and 5:00 PM on any working day between Monday and Friday from 21st May 2018 to 11th June 2018 at NCDIR, Bengaluru. The visitors / representatives of the firms / persons are requested to sign in the register after inspection of the items.
6. No complaint whatsoever will be entertained after the tender submitted before or after the items are lifted. No request for inspection after submission of tender will be accepted.
7. The successful bidder will be required to deposit the total bid amount by means of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Director, NCDIR, Bengaluru, (within three working days of award of contract).
8. If highest qualifying firm fails to accept the bid, the contract will be cancelled and the EMD deposited by such bidder will be forfeited. In such event, an opportunity shall be given to the next highest qualifying eligible tenderer (H-2). If such second highest bidder also does not prefer the sale offer and withdraws from the bidding, after having decided as the highest bidder, the EMD deposited by him/her will also be forfeited to the NCDIR and the proceeding initiated in this notice will be considered as final and unsuccessful.
9. EMD of the successful bidder(s) will be released only after realization of sale proceed amount. EMD of the bidders who fail to honour the bid in prescribed time limit shall stand forfeited. No representation in this regard shall be entertained by this office. EMD amount will not be adjusted in the Sale Amount. EMD of successful bidder(s) shall be released only after successful completion of the sale process. EMD shall be refunded to the unsuccessful tenderers after finalization of Tender.

10. The successful bidder should submit documentary evidence in support of residential status (Ration card/ Voter Identity Card/ PAN, in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firms etc.), the items will be handed over by NCDIR office.
11. The sold items will be removed by the successful bidders within **48 hours of depositing the money at their own expenses**. No assistance/transportation will be provided by NCDIR office. Permission to take out the disposed items from the office premises will not be allowed on holidays, Saturdays and Sundays etc.
12. The rates should be quoted in figures as well as in words for all disposal items. Over writing or any corrections are not allowed.
13. EMD of the firms rescinding their offer, withdrawing or abrogating after submitting the bid shall stand forfeit. Decision of Director, NCDIR, Bengaluru shall be final in this regard.
14. The Director reserves the right to reject all or any tenders in whole or part without assigning any reason thereof at any time.
15. Disputes, if any, shall be subject to jurisdiction in the Court of Bengaluru only.
16. The highest bid once accepted is not transferable to anyone. In case the bidder is a company, the name of the company should be indicated as the bidder. In such cases, the person appearing for the company should have the authorization letter in a proper format issued from a competent authority of the company.
17. Tender should be signed by the authorized signatory only. Photocopy or unsigned tenders not signed by authorized signatory shall be rejected.
18. The firm/person shall alone be responsible for furnishing any false or wrong information and the consequences or loss thereof.
19. As per Government of India rules, the employees or their relatives working in the ICMR or ICMR institutes are not eligible for bidding.
20. The bidder is required to reveal his full name/ name of the authorized signatory of the firms/name of father, full postal address and mobile No.
21. The rates must be quoted as lump-sum basis. Rates quoted for partly items will not be accepted.
22. The rates for total items (**AS IS WHERE IS BASIS**) should be indicated and no separate rate for individual item should be quoted.
23. The bidder will be selected on the basis of the highest rates.
24. The materials will be allowed to be lifted between 10.00 AM to 4.00 PM on working days from Monday to Friday. No picking, Choosing or sorting will be allowed in the premises for the disposal lots.

25. The address given in the tender shall be deemed to be the Purchaser's address and correspondence sent on that address shall be considered to have been delivered to the purchaser. No claim will be entertained for the reason of forfeiture of the sum deposited in case the correspondence is returned back undelivered.
26. There will be ONE LOT of unserviceable items comprising computers, printers, UPS with batteries, copier machine etc. and will be disposed of as is where is basis and the tenderer whose offer is accepted will have to take them out of our premises.
27. Tenderers must submit their tender in the enclosed form only, duly signed, with name and address written in block letters. One copy of these terms and conditions duly signed on all the pages must be submitted along with completed tender form.
28. The list of unserviceable items is indicated in the Annexure-I. The bid not received in the prescribed format will be summarily rejected.
29. The term and condition of this tender document are the part of the contract document related with the execution of the contract.
30. The selection of successful bidder shall be made on the rate offered by the bidder keeping in the view of terms & conditions and specification laid under tender document.
