

Relative Proportion (%) of Clinical Extent of Disease

"Locoregional" was the commonest presentation of clinical extent of disease for all the head and neck cancer sites.

The highest proportion was for Hypopharynx cancer (males 76.9% and females 72.2%).

The age-adjusted incidence rates for Head and Neck Cancers

- In India, the North East Region reports a higher incidence of Head & Neck Cancers
- In males, the highest incidence rate is reported in East Khasi Hills district (78.5 cases per 100,000 males)
- In Females, Papumpare district (21.7 cases per 100,000 females) had the highest incidence rate

Annual Percent Change (APC) in Age Adjusted Incidence Rates (AAR) - Head & Neck Cancers

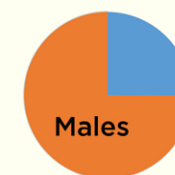
Significant increase -

- Males - Aurangabad, Delhi, Chennai and Bhopal PBCRs
- Females - Nagpur PBCR

Significant decrease -

- Males - Barshi rural and Mumbai
- Females - Bangalore, Mumbai and Kollam district PBCRs

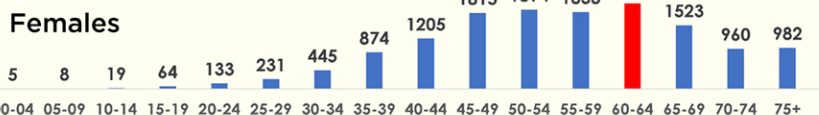
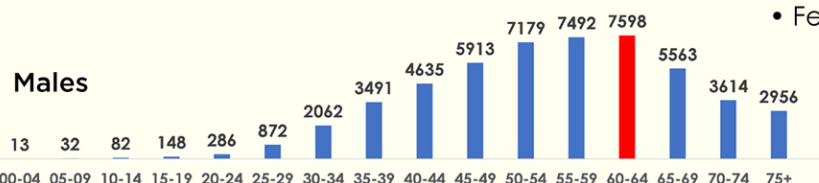
Head & Neck cancers cases, 7.5%
