The instructions, specifications given herein will be strictly binding on the tenderers and deviation, if any, makes the tender liable to be considered invalid. Tenders incorporating additional conditions by the tenderers will be rejected summarily.

Before submitting the tender, the tenderer shall examine carefully all specifications and drawings. Contractor shall be required to enter into an agreement with the National Centre for Disease Informatics & Research, Bengaluru governing the terms of the contract on Non-judicial stamp as per the pro-forma enclosed.

- 1. As a token of their acceptance, the tenderers have to return following documents duly signed on all the pages with official seal.

- 2. A token Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs.67500/- is to be deposited by way of Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque drawn on any Nationalized / Scheduled Bank only (Not from any cooperative bank/society) in favour of 'Director, National Centre for Disease Informatics and Research' payable at Bengaluru. EMD shall be returned to unsuccessful tender(s) immediately but not later than one month from the date of opening of the tender. No interest will be paid on the Earnest Money deposited with NCDIR. EMD and Tender fee are applicable for contractors having valid MSME/ NSIC registration certificates.
- 3. Tender should be placed in double sealed cover super scribing "Tender for renovation of toilets at ICMR Complex-Nirmal Bhavan, Bengaluru'.
- 4. The Contractor shall furnish his/firm's GSTN.
- 5. Incomplete tenders will be rejected. Overwriting in the 'Commercial bid' is not permitted and shall be rejected.
- 6. Telegraphic and conditional offers shall not be accepted.
- 7. Tenders will be received at NCDIR, Bengaluru up to 3.00 p.m. on 28.1.2020 and will be opened on the same day at 3.30 p.m. in the meeting room on 2nd floor of NCDIR, ICMR Complex-Nirmal Bhavan, Poojanahalli Road, Bengaluru 562110 in presence of tenderers, if any present, at the time of opening of the tender. Offer received after the due date and time shall not be accepted.
- 8. The authorities of NCDIR, Bengaluru do not bind themselves to accept the lowest tender, and reserve the right to reject or accept any or all tenders wholly or partially without assigning any reason whatsoever.





- 9. Eligibility criteria: CLASS I Contractors should have a permanent engineering organization capable of dealing with large works in all their stages. They should have sufficient machinery and tools, etc. at their disposal for which they should also submit details. They should submit along with their application full details about their engineering organization. The applicant should have successfully completed at least 3 civil construction or renovation works in Central/State government departments/organizations/autonomous bodies/corporations each costing not less than Rs. 50.00 lakhs or 5 works in central/statement government departments/autonomous bodies/PSUs or large organisations etc., each costing not less than Rs.30 lakhs during the last five years, on the date of application. The applicant shall submit along with the application the certificates of the aforesaid works from the clients. The applicant should furnish a solvency certificate for not less than Rs.50 lakhs from his bankers. Such certificate shall be issued by a scheduled bank and shall be submitted along with Part 1 of the tender.
- 10. Tender must be submitted in two separate sealed covers marked PART-I and PART-II.

General Terms and Conditions

General terms and conditions for submission of tender for renovation of toilets at ICMR Complex, Nirmal Bhavan, Poojanahalli Road, Bengaluru 562110.

- 1. Tenderer shall be required to take up the work of renovation of toilets at ICMR Complex, Nirmal Bhavan, Bengaluru as per the specifications, quantity and drawings provided, complete in all respects and in finished condition as per the completion schedule given in Clause No.6 of terms and conditions.
- 2. The tenderer shall not be a relative of any employee of the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) or the Institutes under the control of ICMR. The Contractor shall submit the following documents within 7 (seven) days from the date of placement of the work order.
 - i. Duplicate copy of the work order duly signed and stamped by the tenderer.
 - ii. The original Agreement governing the terms and conditions of the Contract on Non-judicial stamp paper as per the Pro-forma enclosed.
- 3. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) amount Rs.67,500/- (Rupees one lakh fifty thousand only) and Tender Fee (Non-refundable) amount Rs. 500/- (Rupees five Hundred only) should be submitted in separate envelops in the form of two separate Demand Drafts drawn in favour of the Director, NCDIR payable at Bengaluru. Tender/ Bid submitted without the EMD & Tender fee would be summarily rejected. Micro & Small Enterprises registered under Single point registration scheme of NSIC are exempted from payment of EMD and Tender Cost. Copy of such registration certificate may be attached.
- 4. In case, the Contractor does not comply with the Clause No.3 or refuses to accept the offer after finalization or within 7 days from the date of placement of the order as per the finalized and accepted terms and conditions, the order is liable to be cancelled forthwith without any further reference and the EMD shall be forfeited.
- 5. **Price:** The price and rates indicated shall include cost of all raw materials required for the work, cost of transportation of raw materials and cost of labour for Renovation of toilets at ICMR Complex, Nirmal Bhavan, Poojanahalli Road, Bengaluru-562110. GST on the value of work to be executed shall be clearly mentioned. TDS will be deducted at source as per rules. The price and rate quoted shall be firm and fixed for the entire period of execution of the work and no escalation of rate on any ground whatsoever shall be applicable.
- 6. <u>Time of Completion</u>: Time is the essence of this work. The entire work shall be completed within 4 weeks (Four weeks) from the date of issue of Letter of Intent.
- 7. Penalty Clause: The Contractor shall strictly observe the time allowed for carrying out the works as stipulated in Clause No.6. The work shall, throughout the stipulated period of the contract, be proceeded with due diligence (time being deemed to be the essence of the contract). Tenderer shall pay to NCDIR an amount equal to 1% of the amount of the contract value for every week or a part thereof that the work may remain incomplete as per the completion schedule stipulated in Clause No.6, subject to a maximum compensation of 10% of the contract value after which period, appropriate action will be taken by NCDIR as deemed fit. NCDIR may extend the time for completion of the tendered work at its discretion on the written request of





the Contractor for such purpose provided that NCDIR considers the reasons for such extension as genuine, sufficient and acceptable.

- 8. Every effort should be made by the Contractor to complete the work within the specified time schedule. In case, the tenderer fails to complete the work within the specified time as per the finalized and accepted terms and conditions, NCDIR shall have the right to either impose the Penalty Clause or cancel the order or both. The decision of NCDIR in this regard shall be final and binding on the Contractor. The Contractor cannot claim any compensation for such cancellation or termination of contract.
- 9. Security deposit equivalent to 10% of the gross value of the work order after adjusting the EMD of Rs.67,500/- as at Clause No. 3, shall be deducted from their bill towards security deposit. In case the total value of work executed exceeds the value of the work order, security deposit for the excess amount will also be deducted from the bill of the tenderer and will be refunded to the tenderer as per clause 12. No interest shall be paid on the security deposit retained with NCDIR. The security deposit shall be released as per conditions stated at Clause 12.
- 10. <u>Inspection:</u> The Contractor shall commence the work as per the terms and conditions of the tender. Any defects pointed out by the competent authorities of NCDIR during the course of the work have to be promptly rectified by the tenderer at his own cost, including material cost, to ensure desired quality of work, failing which action shall be taken as deemed fit by NCDIR and the additional cost incurred in rectifying the defects by engaging other agency shall be recovered from the tenderer. The decision of NCDIR in this regard shall be final and binding on the Contractor.
- 11. <u>Terms of payment:</u> No advance payment shall be made by NCDIR under any circumstances. The final payment within 30 days from the date of receipt of final bill/invoice duly supported by satisfactory inspection/work completion certificate from the NCDIR authorities.
- 12. **Defect liability period:** The defect liability period shall be for a period of **one year** from the date of completion of the work. The Contractor shall be responsible for rectification of the defects in the work of renovation of toilets at ICMR Complex-Nirmal Bhavan for a period of one year from the date of virtual completion of the work. The Contractor shall rectify the defects/defective parts within the specified time to complete satisfaction of the competent authority of NCDIR, failing which, NCDIR shall have the right to get the defects rectified through some other agency at the Contractors own risk and cost which will be adjusted from the security deposit. Decision of NCDIR in this regard shall be final and binding on the Contractor. The security deposit shall be refunded to the Contractor on completion of the defect liability period of one year from the virtual date of completion of the work without any interest, and after deduction of the cost of rectification, if any, carried by NCDIR, as per clause 10 hereinabove.
- 13. Bad workmanship will not be accepted and should be rectified at the site by the Contractor at its own cost as per specifications and directions given by the authorized representatives of NCDIR. The decision of the competent authority of the NCDIR as to items of bad workmanship and proper replacement/rectification shall be final and binding on the Contractor.





- 14. Specifications of the items under tender are enclosed for guidance. However, ambiguity in the specifications, if any, shall be promptly brought to the notice of the authorities of NCDIR for clarifications during the mobilization period. The Contractor shall make no deviation from the approved specifications without the prior written approval of the competent authorities of the NCDIR.
- 15. The Contractor shall be liable to pay compensation as per Workmen's Compensation Act for any kind of injury resulting in temporary or permanent disability or loss of life of any employees who are deployed by the Contractor at the worksite during the time of execution of the said work. The Contractor shall indemnify National Centre for Disease Informatics and Research against any such liability.
- 16. The authorities of NCDIR reserve the right to amend, alter or modify the bill of quantities, specifications and drawings of the work as mentioned above, if necessary.
- 17. The authorities of NCDIR, who do not bind themselves to accept the lowest tender, reserve the right to accept/reject any or all tenders wholly or partially without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 18. <u>Access:</u> The authorities of NCDIR shall have free access to the worksite and the Contractor shall cooperate with them for inspection and/or examination and testing of the materials and workmanship.
- 19. The Contractor shall obtain necessary trade and other licenses as may be required to carry on the tendered job and shall also be responsible for compliance of all rules and regulations which may be in force from time to time by the appropriate authority at his/their own cost.
- 20. The quantities mentioned in the BoQ are provisional and may vary depending upon the site conditions. The Contractor shall use only branded and high quality sanitary ware for the renovation work.
- 21. Sealed Tenders will be received at NCDIR, Bangalore up to 3.00 p.m. on 28.1.2020 and will be opened on the same day at 3.30 p.m. in the meeting room on th3 2nd floor of NCDIR Block, ICMR Complex Nirmal Bhavan, Poojanahalli Road, Bengaluru 562110 in presence of tenderers, if any present, at the time of opening of the tender. Tenders received after the due date and time shall not be accepted. (The quoted price should be valid for a period of 3 months from the date of submission of the tender).
- 22. **Scope of Work:** The work shall comprise of repair and renovation of 18 nos., of toilets situated on different floors of ICMR Complex-Nirmal Bhavan including the toilets on the ground floor attached to the Canteen Annex of Nirmal Bhavan building. The work shall be carried out without causing any inconvenience to the users of toilets and without any disturbance in the normal functioning of the offices in ICMR Complex.
- 23. Work will be awarded to the successful bidder who has quoted the lowest rate as per the BoQ including the materials required for the work.
- 24. The building drawings are attached for reference purpose.





- 25. All other conditions given in the tender document under various sections shall stand valid and form an integral part of this agreement and the Contractor shall abide by them.
- 26. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor: a) to arrange necessary inspection of the raw materials and b) to carry out the work at site.
- 27. All disputes and differences of any kind between the Contractor and the NCDIR, except quality of workmanship, whatever arising out of or in connection with the order on carrying out the work (whether during the progress of the work or after their completion and whether before or after the determination, abandonment or breach of the terms and conditions of the order) shall be referred to the sole arbitration of a person nominated by the Director, National Centre for Disease Informatics & Research, Bengaluru whose decision in this regard shall be final and binding on both the Contractor and the NCDIR.

1. <u>Time of Completion:</u> Time is the essence of this contract. **The entire work shall be completed within 4 weeks (Four Weeks)** from the date of placement of Letter of Intent for execution of the work of renovation of toilets at ICMR Complex, Nirmal Bhavan, Bengaluru-562110.

2. Penalty Clause:

The Contractor shall strictly observe the time allowed for carrying out the works as detailed in Clause No.1 hereinabove. The work shall, throughout the stipulated period of the contract, be proceeded with due diligence (time being deemed to be the essence of the contract) and the Contractor shall pay to NCDIR an amount equal to 1% of the amount of the contract value for every week or a part thereof the work that may remain incomplete as per the completion schedule stipulated in Clause No.1 hereunder, subject to a maximum compensation of 10% of the contract value after which period, appropriate action will be taken by NCDIR as deemed fit. NCDIR may extend the time of delivery of the tendered job at its discretion on the written request of the Contractor for such purpose provided that NCDIR considers the reasons for such extension as genuine, sufficient and acceptable.

3. Every effort should be made by the Contractor to complete the work within the specified time schedule. In case the Contractor fails to comply with Clause No.1 hereinabove within the specified time schedule as per the finalised and accepted terms and conditions, NCDIR shall have the right to either impose Penalty clause or cancel the order. The decision of NCDIR in this regard shall be final and binding on the Contractor.





04 **Security deposit:**

Security deposit equivalent to 10% of the gross value of the work order after adjusting the EMD of Rs.67500/-, shall be deducted from their bill towards security deposit as at Clause No. 3 of the GTC. In case the total value of work executed exceeds the value of the work order, security deposit for the excess amount will also be deducted from the bill of the tenderer and will be refunded to the tenderer as per clause 20 of GTC. No interest shall be paid on the security deposit retained with NCDIR. The security deposit shall be released as per conditions stated at Clause12 of the GTC.

4. **Inspection:**

The Contractor shall commence complete the work strictly as per the time schedule. Any defects pointed out by the competent authorities of NCDIR during the course of the work have to be promptly rectified by the tenderer at its own cost, including material cost, to ensure desired quality of work, failing which action shall be taken as deemed fit by NCDIR and the additional cost incurred in rectifying the defects by engaging other agency shall be recovered from the tenderer. The decision of NCDIR in this regard shall be final and binding on the Contractor.

5. <u>Terms of payment:</u> No advance payment shall be made by NCDIR under any circumstances. The final payment within 30 days from the date of receipt of invoice/Bill duly supported by satisfactory inspection/work completion certificate from NCDIR authorities.

TDS as applicable shall be deducted from the bill. The agencies should have a valid GSTN.

The Contractor shall be responsible for rectification of the defects of work of renovation of toilets at ICMR Complex, Nirmal Bhavan for a period of one year from the date of completion of the job. The Contractor shall rectify the defects/defective parts within the specified time to complete satisfaction of the competent authority of NCDIR, failing which NCDIR shall have the right to rectify the defects at the Contractors own risk and cost which will be adjusted from the security deposit. Decision of NCDIR in this regard shall be final and binding on the Contractor.
- 7. The security deposit shall be refunded to the Contractor on completion of the defect liability period of one year from the virtual date of completion of the work without interest and after deduction of the cost of rectification, if any carried by NCDIR as per clause 10 of GTC.
- 8. Bad workmanship will not be accepted and should be rectified by the Contractor at its own cost as per specifications and directions given by the authorized representatives of NCDIR. The decision of the competent authority of NCDIR as to items of bad workmanship and proper replacement/rectification shall be final and binding on the Contractor.
- 9. Specifications of the items under tender are enclosed for guidance. However, any ambiguity in the specifications shall be promptly brought to the notice of NCDIR for clarification during the mobilization period. The Contractor without written approval of this office shall make no deviation from the approved specifications.





- 10. NCDIR shall not be liable for any kind of injury resulting in temporary or permanent disability or loss of life of any employee who is deployed by the Contractor at the work site during the execution of the said work.
- 11. The authorities of NCDIR reserves the right to amend, alter or modify the bill of quantities, specifications and drawings of the work as mentioned above, if necessary.
- 12. <u>Access:</u> The Authorities of NCDIR shall have free access to the work site where materials are brought / prepared or constructed for the contract and the contractor shall cooperate with them for inspection and/or examination and testing of the materials and workmanship.
- 13. The Contractor shall obtain necessary trade and other licenses as may be required to carry out the tendered job and shall also be responsible for compliance of all rules and regulations which may be in force from time to time by the appropriate authority at his/their own cost.
- 14. The Contractor shall not under any circumstances whatsoever transfer wholly or partially this contract/agreement to any other person(s)/firm/company or assign the contract/agreement or benefits of this contract/agreement to any other party for any reason whatsoever in which case this contract/agreement will automatically stand cancelled.
- 15. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor:
 - a) To arrange necessary inspection of the raw materials and the completed work at every stage of renovation of toilets.

 - c) To carry out the work in a phased manner so as not affect the normal working of the offices in the ICMR Complex.
- 16. All disputes and differences of any kind between the Contractor and NCDIR except quality of workmanship and materials whatever arising out of or in connection with the order on the carrying out the work (whether during the progress of the work or after their completion and whether before or after the determination, abandonment or breach of the terms and conditions of the order) shall be referred to the sole arbitration of a person nominated by the Director, National Centre for Disease Informatics & Research, whose decision in this regard will be final and binding on both the Contractor and NCDIR.
